Fundraising online is a great way to reach lots of people quickly. Using social networking and online giving sites can really boost your fundraising. Romsey Mill has an account with JustGiving and by setting up your own fundraising page, you can provide an efficient and easy way for people to support you. Follow the instructions below to set up your JustGiving page.

- Go to <http://www.justgiving.com/romseymill>
- Click on the 'Raise money for us' button
- Click on the 'Doing your own thing' section
- Fill in the details of the trek, including the date which is 25th April 2014
- On the section 'Is your charity contributing to the cost of your fundraising', click yes, as the cost of accommodation is covered.
- Choose your JustGiving web address
- Click on 'Create your page'.

You can then personalise your page with a photo and a message to potential sponsors about why you've chosen Romsey Mill.

Ask everyone to sponsor you by emailing a request with a link to your page, to all your friends, family and colleagues.

Keep emailing updates as your training and fundraising progresses.

Put a link to your fundraising page on your social network profile.

Adapt your personal and work email signature to include a line about the event you are doing and include your JustGiving web page address.
